## ABOUT THE CAMP AT COLEGIO MONTEGRANDE

- Sport activities (handball, volleyball, basketball, sport games, etc.).
- Workshop crafts (painting, drawing, games and instruments making, decorating, mask making, origami).

13:30 a 15:00 Lunch and free time.

15:00 a 17:45 Group games (gymkhana, Great Games, sports competitions, etc.).

In addition to this, there will be two nights where the participants will take part in different activities organized by the camp: magical bonfire, night games, choreography and jokes competitions, etc. On these occasions, the participants will sleep in tents in the school under the supervision of the camp instructors. Tents will be provided by the school.

Participants will also enjoy several excursions: Cerceda waterpark, beach and Mount San Pedro, where our Treasure Hunt game will take place. Besides this, we will celebrate a traditional Spanish day with food, popular games, costumes, music and dance.
